## LAUNCH OF GS1 SINGAPORE SOLUTION CENTRE: OPERATIONALISING GS1 STANDARDS

**SINGAPORE:** On 23 March 2020, GS1 Singapore will launch the inaugural 'GS1 Singapore Solution Centre'. The launch is a closed-door event that will be attended by the GS1 Singapore Solution Centre sponsors, members of the GS1 Singapore Board of Directors and Singapore Manufacturing Federation, along with key personnel of GS1 Singapore.

GS1 Standards are the most widely used open standards for supply chain management in the world. The GS1 Singapore Solution Centre is a showcase of how GS1 standards can be operationalised into business systems and used along the supply chain processes. This will address the fundamentals of the adoption of GS1 Standards, which is extremely valuable to businesses in sectors such as retail, online market place, food service, healthcare, technical industries, transport and logistics.

The showcase aims to provide a better understanding of the use and implementation of GS1 standards. As such, tours of the GS1 Singapore Solution Centre will be conducted for visitors. A 25-minute tour will showcase 4 stations of digital solutions, sponsored by GS1 Singapore Solution Partners, including live demonstration of a typical process flow from GS1 Singapore membership application to manufacturing, warehousing, and distribution to retailers down to the consumer.

## The 4 Stations of the GS1 Singapore Solution Centre

Station 1: Retail CPG supply chain solution A company begins with joining GS1 Singapore to obtain barcodes for products, and the use of these barcodes for identification of the products in the process of manufacturing, warehousing, distribution to retailers, and in engaging the consumer.	Station 2: RFID Solution  Demonstration of GS1 Electronic Product Codes (EPC) frequently used in RFID tags for Retail – Fashion / Apparels.
Station 3: Barcode Verification  Demonstration of a verification machine to decode the scan-ability of barcodes.	Station 4: Healthcare Product Serialisation Demonstration of the use of GS1 Data Matrix on healthcare products for Track & Trace purposes.
